

WASC Senior College and University Commission
Statement on the Status of San Diego Christian College

On November 6, 2020, the WASC Senior College and University Commission (WSCUC) voted to issue a Warning to San Diego Christian College (SDCC).

A Warning reflects the Commission's finding that an institution fails to meet one or more of the Standards of Accreditation. The Commission has determined that San Diego Christian College is not in compliance with WSCUC Standard 3. Under U.S. Department of Education regulations, when the Commission finds that an institution fails to meet one or more of the Standards of Accreditation, it is required to notify the institution of these findings and give the institution no longer than two years from the date of this action to correct the deficiencies. It is the responsibility of the Commission to determine, at the end of the sanction period, whether the institution has made the necessary corrections and has come into compliance with Commission Standards.

The accredited status of SDCC continues during the Warning period and students' status within the college is not affected by this sanction.

The Commission's decision to issue SDCC a Warning is subject to the terms and conditions contained in the Commission Action Letter dated November 17, 2020.
