BACHELOR OF ARTS: PSYCHOLOGY

Program Description:

The *Psychology* program is designed to combine the basic areas of psychology and research methods with a focus on the biological, cognitive, and social basis of all behavior. Students will consider the spiritual foundation of human behavior and biblical teaching about human life. Through the program assignments and research process, students will engage in service-learning, complete a Capstone research project and prepare for potential graduate studies learning opportunities.

Students pursuing the *Psychology* degree will:

- Evaluate the interactions of the biological, cognitive, social, and spiritual aspects of human behavior.
- Choose and apply appropriate methods of psychological inquiry and critically evaluate sources of psychological literature.
- Use technology to find and analyze information, including library databases, internet, and statistical analyses.
- Demonstrate competency in understanding and working with individual and cultural differences.
- Apply psychological research and biblical teachings to a variety of settings (e.g. business, community, counseling, research, education).
